Who can do this course?



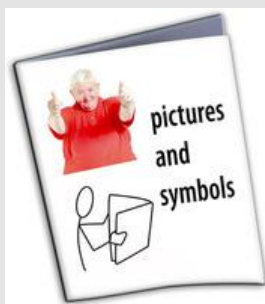
This is a QQI Level 2 course.

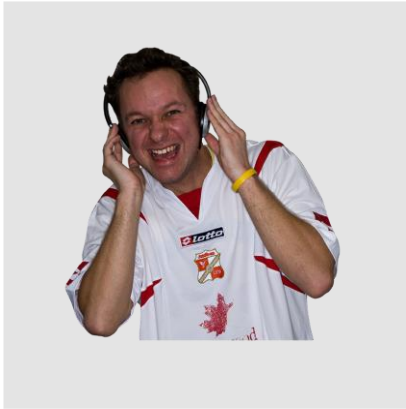

- The assessment you will have to do



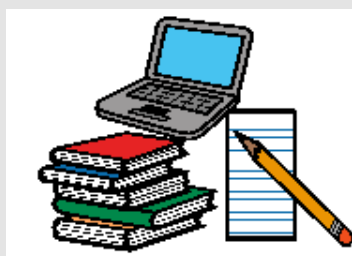

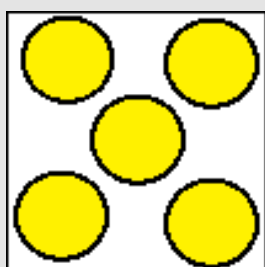
How long will the course take?

Learn the names of different musical instruments.



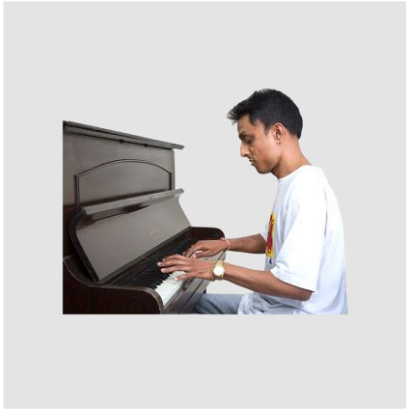
Learn about the different types of musical instruments.

What will I learn on this course?

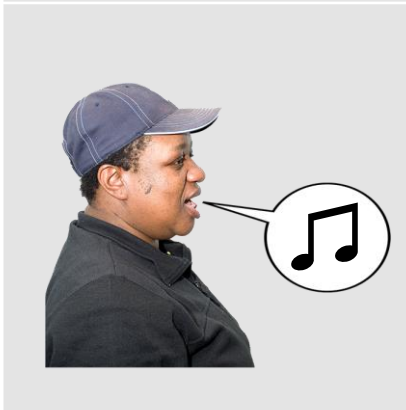


Make music with different instruments.
