Sit on the floor with your legs in front and a little bent and hold the steering wheel. Off we go.


Can you make a sound like a tractor?


This road is very bumpy. Let's bounce along in the tractor.

It is very mucky so we have to put on our boots.




Squelch, squelch, squelch.....

That's great fun. You are very fast.


There is a fence. Who can jump the fence?

Well done everyone.







Let's go over to the barn now and see if we can find the chickens.
