OTC - Training & Education

In collaboration with the Open Training College, our Rights Education & Training Team will develop, implement and evaluate education & training inputs into developing a rights-based culture within St Michael's House.



Volunteer Programme

A volunteer programme will be set up and take a community network approach. By involving local people as volunteers, we will create a robust volunteer network that can support service users achieve their goals.
