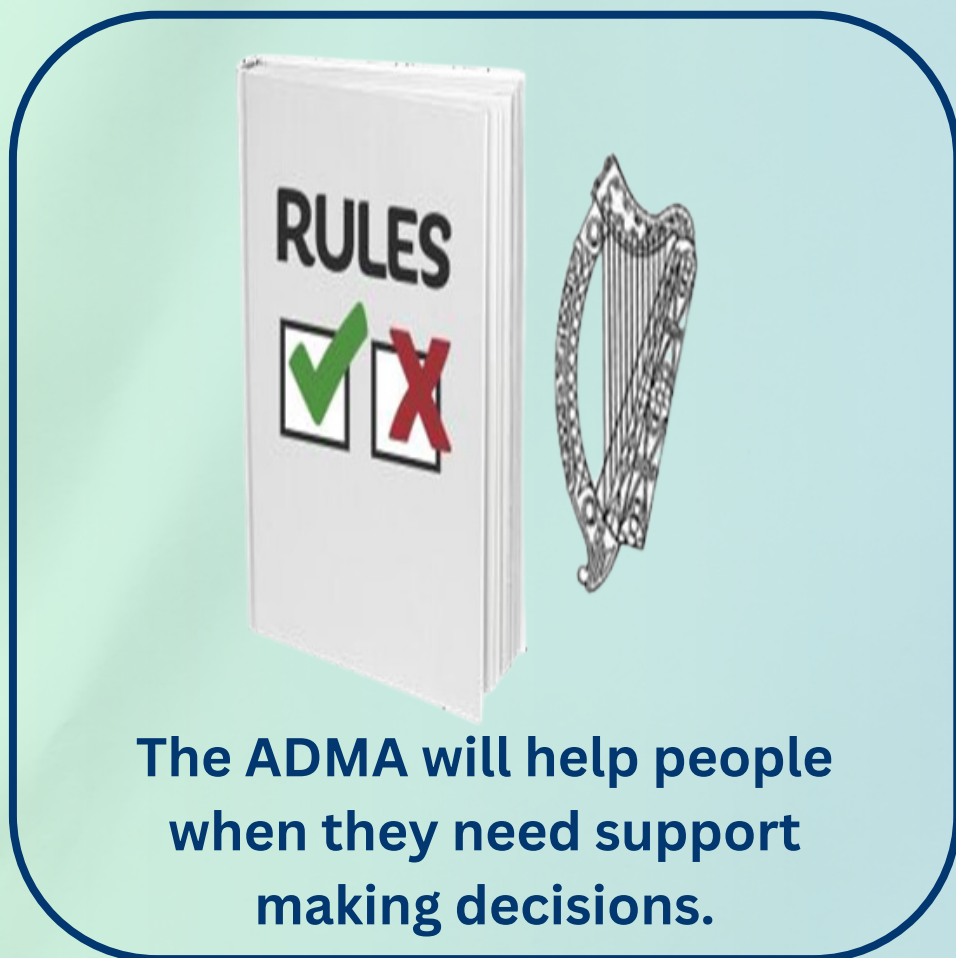
People make decisions all the time.
