

Using your information

	<p>We will use your information to contact you with a screening appointment or test.</p>
	<p>We will use your information to offer you more tests or treatment if you need them.</p>
	<p>We will use your information to offer you screening tests in the future.</p>
	<p>We will use your information to help us give you and other people a good quality service.</p>

Sharing your information



We will only share your information with others involved in your care, for example, your doctor.



We may share your information with national programmes, such as the National Diabetes Programme.







We will ask for consent to use your information for research.



We may use your test pictures for teaching or to check the work of staff at a screening service.
